Minimum Qualifications:

None.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Considerable knowledge of general construction and maintenance tools, equipment and practices.

Considerable knowledge of the precautions necessary to work safely with and around automotive and mechanical equipment.

Ability to operate trucks, tractors, and other light automotive equipment. Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions.

Physical strength sufficient to perform heavy manual labor, often under adverse weather conditions. See Functional Job Description.

Experience and Training:

High school graduate or the equivalent. Considerable experience as a laborer in maintenance and construction work. Must possess a valid Connecticut driver's license. Or any other equivalent combination of experience and training which provides a demonstrated potential for performing the duties of the position.

Laborer II Functional Job Description:

Drive - 30%- 100% of time operating tractors, trucks, pick ups, snow plow trucks, etc.

Stand - 20-90% of time. 90% of time would be when being a flagger at work site.

Walk - 1%- 50% of time.

Sitting - 1 - 90% of time- 90% of time during leaf pick up, snow plowing

Push/Pull - 1 - 30% of time. Moving equipment.

Handling Tools/Equipment - 30% - 80% of time. Shovels, rakes, snow blower, lawn mower, hand tools, chain saws, powered equipment and tools.

Squat/Bend - 1%- 30% of time.

Lifting - 1% - 80% of time. Leaf pick-up, bags of cement (80 pounds), powered tools and hand tools, chain saws, street debris, tree limbs, etc.

Laborer II Functional Job Description: (cont.)

Carrying - 1% - 60% of time. Loading and unloading tool/equipment from trucks. Limbs and brush into wood chippers. Carrying ladders.

Climbing - 1% - 10% of time. Ladders, in and out of trucks and powered equipment.

Seeing - 100% of time.

Hearing - 100% of time.

Inside - 10% of time

Outside - 90% of time. Adverse weather. Extreme cold/heat, snow, rain, sleet.
