Protect yourself and loved ones this respiratory virus season by getting your annual flu shot! Our Public Health Clinic is open:

- >> Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm
- >> Until 6 pm on December 3, 10, and 17, 2024.

Free flu shots for Meriden residents, ages 18 and younger, regardless of health insurance status. For adults, the flu shot is \$20 (cash or check). We accept Connecticare, Cigna, Aetna, and other select health insurance plans. Call (203) 630-4234 to schedule an appointment.

Every U.S. household is eligible to order 4 free at-home tests. Your order of COVID tests is completely FREE - you won't even pay for shipping. Tests will start to be shipped to homes the week of September 30.

In-Person QPR Suicide Prevention Training

- ✓ How to question, persuade, and refer someone to help.

Save a Life: Overdose Education & Naloxone Training

This training is an essential part of overdose prevention education where participants learn what an overdose looks like and how to reverse one.

You will learn:

- → Signs & symptoms of an overdose
- → What naloxone (Narcan®) is and how to administer it
- → Local resources and support

All attendees will receive a naloxone kit, certificate of completion, and other prevention resources. Training are FREE and open to Meriden residents and organizations.
